

# VENUE SAFETY INFORMATION

**Smoking and Vaping** is not permitted on UCL's campus including in outside areas.

## Action in an Emergency:

### Fire

- If you discover a fire, raise the alarm by breaking the glass at the nearest call point, the alarm system will then sound continuously and the building must be evacuated immediately.
- Do not use the building lifts.
- Use all emergency exits, not just the main exit.
- Go straight to the building assembly point (**The Main Quad**) and do not assemble immediately outside the building as this may obstruct others evacuating the building.
- Do not re-enter the building until instructed to do so by the fire brigade or a responsible staff member.
- If you need assistance please let a festival volunteer or staff member know.

### First Aid

- If you need a first aider or need help in an emergency please let a festival volunteer or staff member know.

### Security, Theft and Possible Intruders

- Do not leave personal possessions unattended at any time.
- Report any incident/concern to festival staff or volunteers.
- Should you discover an intruder, please let a festival volunteer or member of staff know.

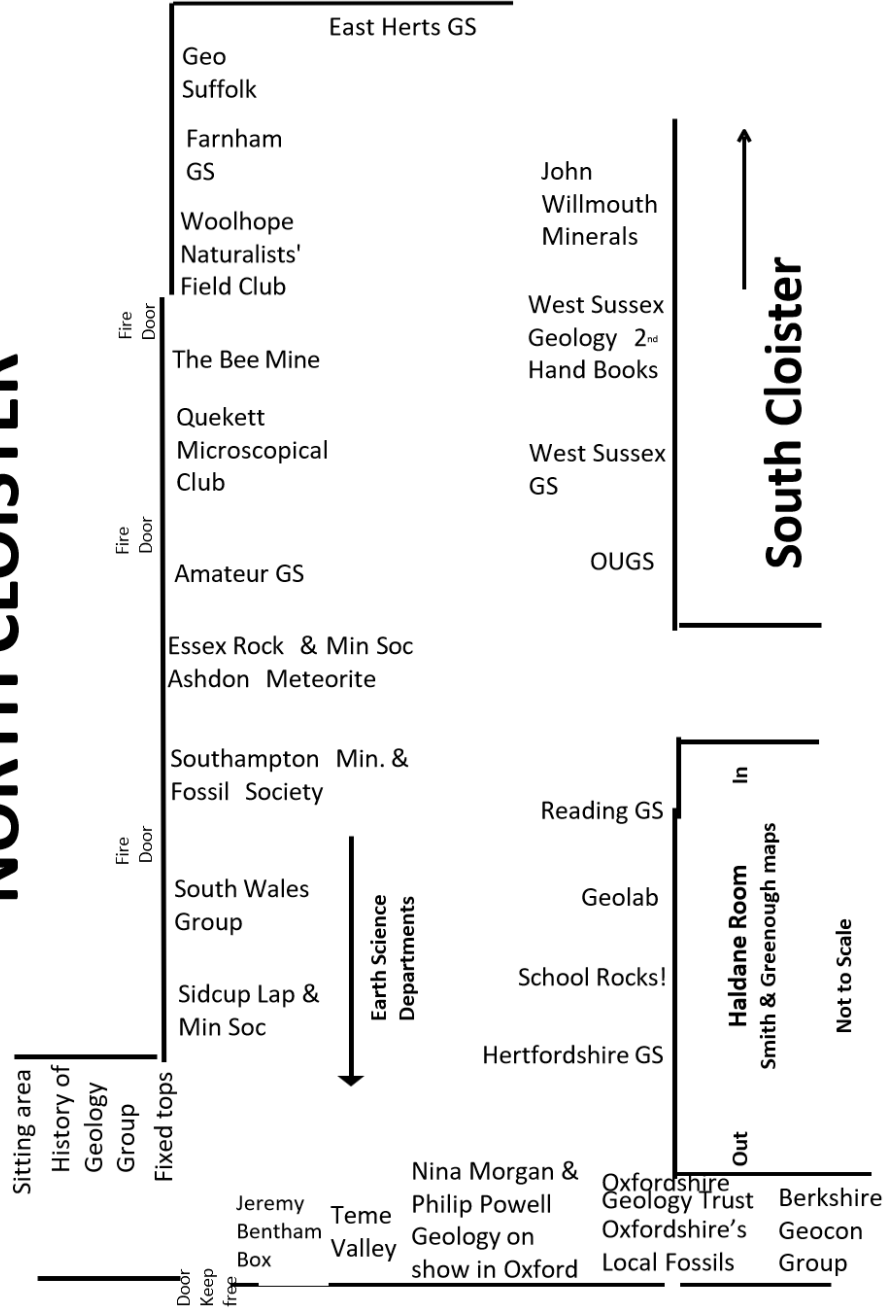
